**History...** The patient is a 27 year old female. The patient presented with symptoms of abdominal pain, fever, and a history of Crohn's Disease.

**Findings...** The patient was found to have abnormal thickening of the wall of the distal portion of small bowel near the terminal ileum. This appearance is compatible with the patient's clinical diagnosis of Crohn's disease.

This image shows the circumferential thickening of the terminal ileum. This is a typical finding of Crohn's Disease. CT (*Computed Tomography*) is useful in the evaluation of Small Bowel Disease and Bowel Obstruction.
